



**Dates:** To be determined.

Arriving in Pamplona the Sunday before the course start date and leaving on the Saturday after the course finalized.

## The program includes:

**Lessons**: **40** lessons of General Spanish and Culture + **20** lessons on History of the Camino de Santiago given through English. History of the Way, it's social and economic impact on the communities through which it passes. **6** hours of lessons per **day**. From Monday to Friday.

#### Accommodation:

- First two weeks: Students have home-stay double room accommodation with half-board (breakfast and dinner) Monday to Friday and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner) at the weekend. Teacher has self-catering apartment accommodation.
- Last two weeks (students + teacher): Hotel accommodation in double or triple rooms with breakfast included.

The accommodation starts on the Sunday before the course start date and ends on the Saturday after the course finalized.







# **Our courses of Spanish:**

- The school offers courses of Spanish for foreigners to suit all levels as set out in the Common European Framework of Reference. The first day of class the student will be given a placement test and will be placed in the level that corresponds to the results of his/her test.
- The methodology used in our courses enables the students to communicate effectively in Spanish, both orally and in writing. In our methodology the student is the protagonist as it is focused on his/her needs and objectives. We understand that the student is the centre of the teaching/learning experience. Our methodology enables the students to carry out the linguistic interaction that is necessary for their daily activities.





#### The school:

- The school is located in a modern building close to the city centre. The teachers are university qualified as well as having specific training in the teaching of Spanish as a second language. They have a long experience in teaching Spanish and Spanish for specific purposes to American University students
- The school has 7 classrooms, a waiting room and the entire school has wifi so those students who bring their laptops with them can use the wifi free of charge within the school installations.
- Near the school there are several coffee-shops, bars and restaurants where students can enjoy a quiet coffee or have a tapa or pintxo as they are known here in Pamplona.





Pamplona is a medium sized city, capital of the Region of Navarra, in the North of Spain close to the border with France. Pamplona is famous worldwide for it's San Fermin festival which take place each year from 6th till 14th July. These festivals were made world famous by the American writer Ernest Hemingway in his book "The sun also rises" or "Fiesta" in its Spanish version. Pamplona is a safe city where students can feel at home. It is not a tourist city so the students will have plenty of opportunities to speak Spanish to the local people while shopping or just out having a quiet coffee.







### **Activities:**

- Some cultural weekends activities: Guggenheim museum, medieval castle, winery, farewell dinner.
- Walking 12 stages of the Camino de Santiago. Start on Monday

# Other services:

There will be a bus at their disposal during the 12 stages that will carry their equipment and will take them back and forth to the hotels during their walking.







- Day 1: Transfer from Pamplona to hotel in the area of Roncesvalles.
- Day 2: Breakfast, walk from Roncesvalles to Akerreta (23 Kilometres). Lunch on their own. Transfer to a hotel in the Roncesvalles area for accommodation.
- Day 3: Breakfast and transfer to Akerreta. Walk from Akerreta to Pamplona (24 kilometres). Lunch on their own and accommodation at hotel in Pamplona.
- Day 4: Breakfast and the group walks to Puente la Reina (22 kilometres). Lunch on their own and then transfer to Pamplona for accommodation.
- Day 5: Breakfast and then transfer to Puente la Reina. Group walks to Estella from Puente la Reina (21 kilometres). Lunch on their own and then transfer to Logroño for accommodation.
- **Day 6:** Breakfast and transfer to Mansilla de las Mulas, the group walks from Mansilla to Leon (18 kilometres). They have lunch on their own. Accommodation in Leon.
- **Day 7:** Breakfast and the group walks to Villadangos (22 kilometres). They have lunch on their own. Transfer to Leon for accommodation.





**Day 8:** Breakfast, Transfer to Villadangos. The group walks to Astorga (26 kilometres) They have lunch on their own. Accommodation at hotel in Astorga.

**Day 9:** Breakfast and transfer to Sarria. The group walks from Sarria to Portomarin (22 kilometres) They have lunch on their own and transfer to hotel in Lugo.

**Day 10:** Breakfast and transfer to Portomarin. The group walks from Portomarin to Palas de Rei (24 kilometres) They have lunch on their own. Transfer to hotel in Lugo.

**Day 11:** Breakfast and transfer to Palas de Rei: The group walks from Palas de Rei to Arzua (30 kilometres). They have lunch on their own and then transfer to the area of Santiago for accommodation.

**Day 12:** Breakfast and transfer to Arzua. The group walks from Arzua to Pedrouzo (20 kilometres) They have lunch on their own and then transfer to area of Santiago for accommodation.

**Day 13:** Breakfast and transfer to Pedrouzo. The group walks from Pedrouzo to Santiago (17 kilometres). They have lunch on their own. Accommodation at hotel in Santiago.

Day 14: Breakfast and then transfer to Santiago Airport. End of services.

#### The price includes:

- Spanish language classes.
- Specific classes on Camino de Santaigo given through English: here we explore the history of the Camino, its social and economic impact on the communities through which it runs.
- Accommodation as described above during the course.
- Transfers and hotels (13 nights at 2 or 3 star hotels) for the duration of the 2 weeks walking tour. This is decribed above.
- Route maps.
- Pilgrim´s scallop shell.
- Pilgrim's passport.
- Insurance.
- 24 hour telephone assistance.

### The price does not include:

- Lunches and dinners during the walk.
